Right to Request Teacher Qualifications**

Dear Parent/Guardian of Plymouth-Shiloh Local School District:

Our district receives federal funds for Title I programs that are part of the Elementary Secondary Schools Act (ESSA). Throughout the school year we will continue to provide you with important information about this law and your child's education.

You have the right to request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher(s). If you request this information, the district will provide you with the following as soon as possible:

- a. If the teacher has met state licensing requirements for the grade level and subjects in which the teacher is providing instruction;
- b. If the teacher is teaching under an emergency status for which state licensing requirements have been waived;
- c. The type of college degree major of the teacher and the field of discipline for any graduate degree or certificate; and
- d. If your child is receiving Title I services from a paraprofessional and, if so, his/her qualifications.

If you would like to request this information, please contact your child's school. Thank you for your interest and involvement in your child's education.
