Plymouth-Shiloh School District Community,

The Ohio Department of Health and the Richland County Public Health Department have designated Richland County Level 3 (Red) in the COVID-19 reporting system for the next week. Level 3 (Red) indicates “very high exposure and spread.” County residents are asked to limit activities as much as possible and to follow all current health orders.

Our Plymouth-Shiloh Local Schools Reopening Plan, passed by our Board of Education in July, states that students and staff will transition to remote learning at level 3 (Red). Staff will report to buildings and all students will learn remotely from home. **This transition to remote learning will start on Monday, October 5 and will continue until further notice.** All students will be expected to follow the guidelines for remote learning in the District Reopening Plan. These guidelines include but are not limited to:

- Students will follow an established school schedule while at home remote learning. Students will be assigned to classes at their school and attendance will be taken. Students will participate throughout the school day in all class activities using their school chromebook. Attendance is mandatory.
- Students will earn grades for their work. Students are expected to complete assignments according to timelines established.

Daily schedules will be communicated to students through their classroom teachers before leaving school on Friday. Information will also be available on our District Facebook Page. Please contact your student’s building office if you have questions or need assistance.

We have had a very positive start to the school year and want this to continue. We all need to work together to keep student learning advancing regardless of the method of lesson delivery. Student safety and learning continue to be our top
