A teacher on the Plymouth High School staff has tested positive for COVID-19. This identified positive staff member was in attendance at school on Wednesday, November 4, 2020. This contact at school was within 48 hours of the onset of symptoms of COVID-19 experienced by the staff member. Contact tracing protocols will be followed to identify students and staff who were in close contact with the positive staff member. Upon recommendation of the Richland County Public Health Department all students and staff who were in close contact with the positive teacher should quarantine for ten days from the contact on November 4, 2020. Students and staff notified of being a close contact will be able to return to school on Monday, November 16 if they do not experience any COVID symptoms during the quarantine period.

All students and staff identified in the contact tracing will receive information from the Richland County Health Department. All students and staff should begin quarantine at home if identified as a close contact. Please contact district building administration if you have any additional questions.
