A student at Plymouth High School has tested positive for COVID-19. This identified positive student was in attendance at school on Monday, November 16, 2020. Contact tracing protocols will be followed to identify students and staff who were in close contact with the positive student. Upon recommendation of the Richland County Public Health Department all students and staff who were in close contact with the positive student should quarantine for fourteen days from close contact on November 16, 2020. Students and staff notified of being a close contact will be able to return to school on Tuesday, December 1 if they do not experience any COVID symptoms during the quarantine period.

All students and staff identified in the contact tracing will receive information from the Richland County Health Department. All students and staff should begin quarantine at home if identified as a close contact. Please contact district building administration if you have any additional questions.
