Holiday Break – No School: Monday, Dec. 21 – Friday, Jan. 1

Monday, Jan. 4 – Friday, Jan. 8: All students PK-12 will participate in remote learning

Monday, Jan. 11: In person instruction will resume for grades PK-12

Athletics and activities will continue throughout the above schedule with daily monitoring and all health and safety procedures and protocols being followed.
