COVID POLICIES FOR QUARANTINING PLYMOUTH-SHILOH SCHOOL DISTRICT Revised October 26, 2021

Household Contact:

- If a student is a household contact they must quarantine for 7 or 10 days following the orders of the Richland Public Health Dept.
 - If a staff member is a household contact then they have an option to either quarantine or test daily. If the daily test is negative employees are required to wear a mask and social distance while at work. If symptoms arise staff must stay home. They may return if symptom free for 24 hours and continue to test negative.

School Exposure or Exposure at School-Related Activities:

Regardless of vaccination or masking status, direct contacts may remain in the classroom environment if they do the following:

- Wear a mask for 14 days after their last date of exposure.
- Self-monitor, or parent-monitor, for symptoms of COVID-19.
- Isolate and get tested if they start to experience symptoms associated with COVID-19 (regardless of level of severity).
- Consistent with guidance for others quarantining in lower-risk environments, students and staff may discontinue these quarantine procedures after seven days if they don't develop symptoms and test negative between days 5-7 (school provided test).

Outside of School exposure (Not Household Contact):

- For Students:
 - Excluded from school for the duration of the recommended quarantine period from the Richland Public Health Dept.
- For Staff:
 - Have the option to quarantine or participate in the daily testing program.

Vaccinated and positive COVID staff and students within the last three months:

• Are not required to quarantine but should wear a mask and monitor symptoms if they are exposed to a positive case for the quarantined period.

Test to Play

Asymptomatic school contacts may continue to participate in extracurricular activities if they do the following:

- Wear a mask when able. (This includes: transportation; locker rooms; sitting/standing on the sidelines: and anytime the mask will not interfere with breathing, the activity, or create a safety hazard.)
- Test on initial notification of exposure to COVID-19 (school provided test)
- Test again on days 5-7 (school provided test). If they are negative at this time they will test out of quarantine procedures.
