Plymouth-Shiloh Local SD Families and Staff,

In order to keep you informed and to also prevent the spread of misinformation please read the following message closely.

We have received word that a threatening email from another country was sent to almost every school in Ohio, including our district, indicating the threat of a bomb. No schools were specifically mentioned. Currently, all of the authorities, including local law enforcement, the Sheriff's Department, and the FBI are working together and believe the email has little to no credibility. They are working to determine the source of the information.

There is no evidence to indicate a specific and credible threat and school activities will proceed tomorrow as normal. The Plymouth Police Department will conduct a search of all buildings this evening along with school administration and will monitor the building throughout the night. The Richland County Sheriff's office has assured us that they are currently conducting additional precautionary security measures and extra patrols to insure the safety of our students, staff and families. Our School Resource Officers, local police and administration will be on heightened alert as well.
