What we are learning:

Math:

- ★ We are at the end of our first division unit; We will be moving on to dividing decimals and operations with fractions (Add/Subtract and Multiply/Divide)
- ★ Additionally, we will regularly review previously taught standards and practice the skills within them. Such as:
 - Adding/subtracting decimals, multiplying/dividing decimals, and identifying place value

Science:

- ★ Force and Motion
 - Balanced/Unbalanced Forces, Gravity, Inertia, Friction, and Mass
- ★ Calculating Speed (distance/time)

Social Studies:

- ★ Geography: Regions
 - Latitude/Longitude

ELA:

- ★ Opinion Essay: Develop opinions on a topic and provide supporting evidence
- ★ Vocabulary Development

Reading:

- ★ Locating and writing main idea statements that include supporting details
- ★ Citing/quoting evidence from the text to support answers to comprehension questions and to draw inferences
- ★ Describing the relationship between 2 or more text on the same topic
- ★ Describing how a character changes over time
